

# Ellwood Community Primary School – Specific Subject Overview

## Sycamore Class – Autumn Term 1

### PE

This term pupils will focus on Badminton. The children will learn to use the serve with consideration of attacking principles. They will learn to change direction to lose an opponent. They will explore an underarm return with consideration of attacking principles. They will learn to select and apply skills and tactics to play competitively. They will learn about sending & receiving: develop passing techniques appropriate to the game with increasing success.

### DT

This term we will be focusing on cooking and nutrition: Adapting a biscuit recipe. The children will be learning a basic biscuit recipe and adapting it for a new audience while considering the cost of ingredients and other expenses against a set budget.



### Computing

This term the focus will be online safety. The year 4 children will be learning how to navigate the internet in an informed, safe and respectful way. Year 5 children will be learning about potential online dangers and safety.



### History

This term the children will learn about Romans. They will learn that changes occur over time and use a timeline to represent this. They will identify when ancient Rome began before identifying significant changes within and across historical periods studied. They will explain the terms BC, AD and BCE. They will learn about who Boudica was and explain the key events in the Boudican revolt of 60-61AD. They will learn about Hadrian's Wall and why it was built. We will develop our knowledge of sources to research Roman legacy before presenting our findings. They children will give reasons for the changes in the features of the period studied e.g. clothes, beliefs, homes



## Autumn Term

### 1

### Music

Based on the theme of Romans the children will be adapting and transposing motifs. The children will learn a new song, singing in time and in tune while following the lyrics, before identify motifs aurally and play a repeated pattern on a tuned instrument. They will create and performing a motif, notating it with reasonable accuracy. They will then transpose their motif, using sharp or flat notes where necessary and change the rhythm. Finally they will combine different versions of a musical motif and perform as a group using musical notation.

### RE

This term we will focus on the unit 'What influence does believing in God as Trinity have for Christians worldviews?' During this unit we will explore the Trinity and what it means for some Christians.

### Life Skills

This term the children will develop our knowledge of 'Make me a Superhero'. This is a Gloucestershire Healthy Living and Learning unit that help the children to explore and develop qualities that can contribute to building resilience.



### Languages

.Our French focus this term we will cover the unit 'Clothes and getting dressed'. The children will learn vocabulary to describe items of clothing building on their previous knowledge.
