

Ellwood Community Primary School – Specific Subject Overview

Sycamore Class – Autumn Term 2



PE

This term the children will have swimming on a Wednesday Afternoon.

They will have PE with Mr English from Prostars on a Tuesday Afternoon. We are also lucky enough to have a additional PE session of cricket on a Wednesday morning with an external specialist.

Art

This terms we will focus on Sculpture. They will learn to develop ideas for 3D work through drawing and visualisation in 2D. They will learn to use more complex techniques to shape materials. They will explore forming shapes using wire.

The children will also think about how art is displayed and finally exploring combining materials to create a sculpture.

Computing

This term the focus will learn about the history of computers. Learning about the key work that took part in Bletchley Park. They will also learn about code braking and the development of technology.



Geography

This term the children will Rivers. We will investigate how rivers are formed. We will look in more detail about the water cycle. We will investigate rivers from around the world before finding out about the causes of flooding and the impact of pollution.

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RE

This term we will investigate the following key questions:

Why do around 2 million Muslims visit Makkah every year, and what happens there?

How do Muslims describe their experience of Hajj?How does Hajj form a link between Muslims today and Muslim history?What is it like for a Muslim on Hajj?

Exploring first-hand accountsHow has Hajj changed in the modern world? Does that matter?.

Music

This term we will be learning about the loves and music of some great composers. We will also be preparing for our Christmas Carol concert.



Life Skills

This term we focus on TEAM (Together Everyone Achieves More) focuses on the positive qualities of a team, learning how to disagree respectfully and communicate effectively. We will look at the key qualities and skills needed for a team to be successful. The lessons address collaborative learning and teach children how to compromise to ensure a group task is completed successfully.

Languages

.Our French focus this term we will cover the unit 'Numbers'. In french we will learn to pronounce, read and write numbers, months of the year, days of the week as well as comparing birthday celebrations in France and England.
