Communication and Language

Understanding the World

We are going to continue to explore the natural world in our 'Forest Adventure' sessions with Mrs Rees. During our Three Billy Goats Gruff week, we will be finding out about the names of baby animals too.



Expressive Arts and Design

Phonics

We will then assess the children's phonic knowledge and we will recap and consolidate previous sounds. We will also be continuing with learning the level 3 helpful words.
