

# Ellwood Community Primary School – Specific Subject Overview

## Sycamore Class – Summer Term 2

### Geography

This term we will be developing pupils' locational knowledge by identifying continents, major countries, and the countries and key cities of North and South America. Pupils explore the position and significance of major global lines, including the Equator, the Northern and Southern Hemispheres, and the Tropics of Cancer and Capricorn. Learning also focuses on understanding human and physical geography through comparisons between regions in Europe and the Americas, including settlement patterns, land use, trade, and the fair and unfair distribution of resources. Pupils further develop geographical enquiry and mapping skills through the use of maps, atlases, globes, and digital mapping to locate places and describe geographical features.

### Art

This term's unit "Craft and design: Fabric of nature" unit allows students to use the tropical rainforest to develop skills in textile-based techniques. They will be introduced to textiles where pupils explore natural forms. This unit encourages children to create repeating patterns inspired by natural textures and environments. Pupils learn to describe textiles, make choices based on material properties, and translate natural imagery into functional fabric designs.



### Music

This term the focus will be on Ludwig van Beethoven (1770–1827) who is one of the most universally revered composers in Western classical music. We will learn that his work was defined the transition from the Classical era to the Romantic period, and he is celebrated for developing the symphony to unprecedented emotional and structural heights



### PE

This term pupils will develop their skills in Athletics. We will focus on speed, pace, sprinting, jumping and throwing techniques. We will also develop techniques for throwing for distance and accuracy.

### Computing

This term's unit 'Skills Showcase, unit focuses on HTML. This 5-lesson unit allows pupils to apply and combine their existing computational knowledge by learning how websites are structured and edited using basic coding languages

### RE

This term we will focus on the key question 'U2.10 How do organised and individual worldviews help people when times get hard?'



### Life Skills

This term the children will complete 'The KS2 Protective Behaviours programme', delivered by Gloucestershire Healthy Living and Learning. This unit is designed to empower pupils to recognize, manage, and report unsafe situations. It equips children with practical strategies to build resilience, understand personal boundaries, and identify support networks

### Languages

.Our unit this term is French will be 'monster pets'. It integrates core grammar (like gender and adjective agreement) with creative vocabulary, as pupils use French descriptors to create, describe, and write about their own fantasy monsters
