Pupil Conferencing

Last week we gathered a selection of pupil's views in Beech, Sycamore and Willow Classes. Children spoke positively about their learning, topics, classrooms, marking and targets. They knew how to improve their work and were able to talk about '4be4me'. Meaning before they rely on a teacher for help, they try to use a book to help, their own brain, their buddy, look at the board and displays and then ask the teacher (book, brain, buddy, boss). This develops good learning behaviour and Independence.
