COVID Update

We currently have 5 members of staff and 15 children throughout the school off with positive COVID-19 results.


Whilst we are experiencing an increased number of cases, please could we ask that parents/carers distance themselves from staff and other parents/carers at drop off/pick up times and if possible only one family member drop off/pick up, therefore, hopefully reducing the spread of the virus.

If your child is showing symptoms the advice is to still obtain a PCR test. If your child has a positive LFD test, they must isolate for a minimum of 5 days. Children can test on day 5 and 6 and if their test is negative on both days, they may return to school. If they are still testing positive you can continue to test your child daily until they have had 2 consecutive negative tests or have isolated for 10 days. (Please see flowchart).

We want to keep school running as smoothly as possible and avoid any class closures.
