Design and Technology

In Design and Technology, we will explore different types of windmills, how they work and key features before designing and constructing our own windmill.



Life Skills

In this unit of work, children will learn about everyday dangers, in the home and outside, and how they can keep themselves safe. Children will also learn rules to keep themselves safe around strangers, both in real life and online. They will be taught about The Underwear Rule, which includes information about appropriate and inappropriate touching and knowing that what is inside their underwear is private. Children will also learn about people who help them and how to get help when needed, as well as their growing responsibility for their own safety.

Computing

Improving Mouse Skills

Year 1- Will learn how to log on and log off a laptop. They will learn how to control the mouse pad, drag and click. The children will then use online software such as sketchpad and paint to create pictures.

Year 2- will learn how to use important keyboard shortcuts, as well as simple editing tools within a word processor including: bold, italics, underline and font colour.

History

In History we will discuss what makes someone an explorer. The children will find out about some significant explorers from the past and present and learn how to place these individuals on a timeline.

RE We will explore the question 'Who is Jewish and how do they live?' Music Learning folk songs and creating sounds to represent three contrasting landscapes: seaside, countryside and city.
