


Ellwood Community Primary School – Core Subject Overview

Year 1 – Summer Term 1

English

As writers, we are going to be using the text, The Naughty Bus to create our own stories. The children will draw story maps, orally rehearse their sentences before writing. We will also write letters to the Naughty Bus to explain the school rules.

We will focus on using capital letters for names of people, places and days of the week. We will continue to revise adjectives, nouns and verbs.



Maths

Multiplication and Division:


As mathematicians, We will learn how to solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division, by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays.

We will learn our 2s, 5s and 10s times tables.

The children will learn how to group and share small quantities.

Fractions:

Children will learn how to recognise, find and name a half as 1 of 2 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. Children will recognise, find and name a quarter as 1 of 4 equal parts of an object, shape or quantity



Science

Plants

This term we will find out what a plant is and explore the school grounds to identify garden plants and identify some wild plants. Whilst observing plants and flowers we will name and label the main parts of a plant and discuss the different functions. The children will identify and name trees, then learn differences between deciduous and evergreen trees.




Ellwood Community Primary School – Specific Subject Overview

Chestnut Class – Summer Term 1

DT

Year 1 will learn different joining techniques to make a hand puppet, they will learn how to join two pieces of fabric together using glue, safety pins and a stapler.

Year 2 will learn how to use a cross-stitch to join two pieces of fabric together to make a small cushion.



Life Skills

As global citizens, the children will think about where money comes from and how it can be used. We will discuss the idea of spending and saving our money and how to keep money safe. The children will identify the difference between the things we want and the things we need.

Computing

As computer experts, we will be using the iPads to create stop motion book trailer.



History

Stone-Age

The children will learn about hunting and gathering in the Stone Age. They will look at and compare Stone Age to Bronze Age homes and clothing

RE

As religious learners, the children will answer the question 'Why does Easter matter to Christians?'



Music

As musicians, Chestnut Class will make links between music, sounds and environments and use percussion, vocal and body sounds to represent calm or stormy seas.
