## Safeguarding Audit

The school has completed the audit of statutory duties and associated responsibilities for schools and settings in relation to 'Keeping Children Safe in Education (Sept 16). It is a legal requirement under SECTION 14B OF THE CHILDREN ACT 20014, for schools and settings to respond to this audit. It is the responsibility of governors to oversee the process and ensure that the school is complying with all the robust requirements of safeguarding, as set out in the document 'Keeping Children Safe in Education' (Sept 16). We feel that we are doing a good job and to ensure our pupils are safe. On our website you can find a copy of our Safeguarding Policies and Early Help offers. Which demonstrate show we try to keep children safe and other professionals and organisations we can refer or signpost families to.

#### School Council

Mrs Marshall meets regularly with the Pupil School Council and talks about a range of different items, including safeguarding, so that the school is also taking into account their views. Our children report they feel safe in school which is great.
