Warm Weather

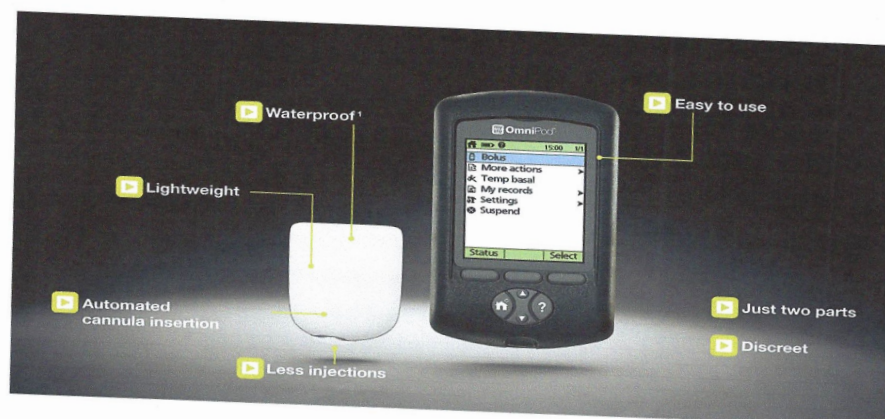

A note from one of our children

As you may be aware we have a child at school who has Type I diabetes. Please see below a special note from him. A copy has been sent home to each family.

Hello my name is Joshua and I'm in year 4.
And I'm writing because I was diagnosed with type one diabetes when I was five, and I would like parents and kids to understand what it actually is. I have something called a insulin pump and that is like a pretend pancreas and a pancreas is a organ which breaks down the sugar you eat and my pancreas can't produce insulin to breaks the sugar down, and insulin is in my pod, what drip feeds me through out the day and the pod is water proof so I don't need to take it of in the bath or swimming. The pod and the handset is Bluetooth. So just because I'M diabetic doesn't mean I can't have sweets and I can do anything except make insulin. I used to have 4-6 injections a day but thanks to everyone who helped me get my pump I only have my pod changed every 3 days, I would like to say a big thank you. It does make me upset when people say I can't have sweets and chocolate. A BIG SHOUT OUT TO MRS CHARLES WHO HELPED ME ALL THE WAY THROUGH IT AT SCHOOL, AND MY MUM, DAD AND MY SISTER ZOE AND EVERYONE WHO HELPED ME, I CAN'T THANK YOU ENOUGH.
