

Travelling through time

The Coast

Geography - Understand geographical similarities and differences by comparing human and physical geography of a small area of the UK and a non-European country. Use basic geographical vocabulary to describe physical features.

English - use good quality texts to write character and setting descriptions. Write posters, letters, diary entries, stories and instructions.

P.E. - children will develop throwing, catching, running and jumping skills and apply them in team and individual sports. They will also learn various balances and gymnastic moves.

Science -

Year 1 - Learn about animals and plants. Learn about seasonal changes and light and dark.

Year 2 - Learn about the importance of exercise, a healthy diet and hygiene. Understand that animals, including humans have offspring that grow into similar adults. Learn about plants, their basic needs and watch plants grow over time.

Music - listen to and respond to music. Learn to use instruments.



History - Compare the appearance of British beaches now and in the past. Compare holidays now with those in the past.

Maths - Year 1 - learn about place value to 50, learn to count in 2s, 5s and 10s, learn about measures. Year 2 - Learn about fractions, measurement including length, height, mass, volume and capacity and time.

RE - learn about what it means to belong to a faith community.

- Draw single or grouped objects
- Use clay to make a model
- Design, make and evaluate a hand puppet
