Why is it sometimes called Free School Meals?

What is the Pupil Premium Grant?

It is a sum of money that is paid directly to schools. We use it in lots of different ways to support children with their learning and to provide them with interesting and exciting opportunities.

Children who are eligible for **Pupil Premium** Funding often receive Free School Meals. If a child stops being eligible for Free School Meals, the school continues to receive the additional funding for six years after the initial application. This is called Ever 6

If a child is in care, has been adopted from care, or has left care, we receive an increased sum of money to support them.

If either parent works in the Services, the small receives a small amount to support the child's specific needs.
