Safeguarding and child protection

At Ellwood Community Primary School we take safeguarding very serious and we always strive to ensure all of our children are safe and prevented from being harmed. All staff in school are trained in safeguarding and child protection and know the procedures to follow if they have any concerns about a child's safety or welfare. We have a duty of care to report any disclosures or concerns to the MASH (Multi Agency Safeguard Hub). The MASH team will give advice or investigate any concerns further if they feel it is needed. We have a number of staff who are trained more extensively in safeguarding and child protection. They are called DSLs (Designated Safeguard Leads). Mrs Milford is the lead Designated Safeguard Lead, along with Miss Peart, Mrs Charles, Mrs Marshall and Mrs Woodhouse, who act as Deputy Designated Safeguard Leads (DDSL).
