- Count actions
- Compare two lengths/ heights using direct comparison; use language of longer and shorter
- Use uniform non-standard units to measure items up to 10 units long
- Put three lengths/ heights in order
- Describe 3D shapes
- Money and real life problems
- Time - days of the week, a minute - actions in a minute
