Science

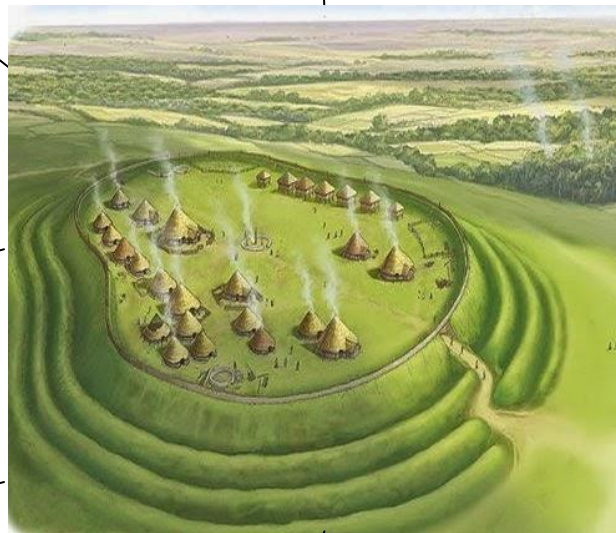
