Medicine and Medication

Please note that schools are not supposed to or required to administer non essential medication. This is the guidance schools are given and staff are advised not to consent to giving medication unless trained and essential.

We have an increasing number of parents requesting staff to administer medication. It is taking up a significant amount of staff time and causing regular disruption for staff, additional to their normal duties, particularly office staff and teaching assistants. This is often being carried out in valuable lesson time or during staff break time, which means it is interrupting their rest break.

Please see the school's medicine policy for further information, it is available on the school website.

If a child requires medication and without it is at a serious health risk, then a health care plan needs to be drawn up in conjunction with a health care professional e.g. doctor, school nurse or paediatrician.

On occasions, if authorised and in agreement, we will administer antibiotics but only if it needs to be given four times a day. Three times a day antibiotics should be given at home: before school, after school and bedtime, not in school time. This also applies to antihistamine medication e.g. piriton/eye drops etc. which should be administered before and after school.

If parents require their child to be given non essential medicine in school they will need to come into school to administer it themselves.
