Underground, overground

Science - develop an understanding of the plants and animals that are found in the Forest of Dean. Which of these animals live above ground and which make their home below ground.

English - learn traditional stories and alternative versions of them and use them to write stories. Write persuasive letters and instructions.

Music - listen to and respond to music.

Maths - learn about multiplication and division (multiples of 2, 5 and 10). Learn about fractions and position and direction, place value to 100 and learn how to tell the time.

RE - learn about what it means to belong to a faith community.

P.E. - children will develop throwing, catching, running and jumping skills and apply them in team and individual sports.

Science -

Year 1 - learn about animals and how they adapt for their habitats. Learn about materials. Observe and describe changes during the seasons.

Year 2 - Learn about plants, their needs and how they grow over time. Learn about habitats and food chains.

Art - Explore the art of Henri Rousseau, creating a class representation of one of his paintings. Learn to sketch and paint still life, experiment with different materials and use the skills we have learnt to produce our own representation of a forest scene.
