

Governors Interests and Register of Interests

Statutory guidance ensures that the Governing Body are required to publish Governor Details. Governors hold an important public office and their identity should be known to their school and wider communities. Governing bodies' should therefore publish on their website information about their members. From September 1 2015 governing bodies are also under a duty to publish on their website their register of interests. The information they should publish should, as a minimum include:
