ART

As Artists, we will review the work of artists like Cecilia Vicuña to use creative techniques. For example, wool wrapping and weaving. The children will learn skills such as measuring, threading, knotting and will learn how to weave.



RE

As religious learners, the children will answer the question 'what can we learn from sacred books?'



Life Skills

As global citizens, we will be using books in the 'No outsiders' scheme. Through reading these stories the children will begin to learn how someone can feel like an outsider, know how to help someone and to ensure everyone feels welcome in our school.

We will use the following books; This is our house, We're all wonders, The Hueys in the New Jumper, The Truth about Old People, Beegu and Planet Omar.

Computing

As computer experts, Year 1 will create a demonstration video on how to use a Bee-Bot. Year 2, will explore programming in games, they will use different blocks in MakeCode to plan and create a simple program.



Geography

As explorers of the world, we will recap the 7 continents and 5 oceans and locate hot and cold areas in relation to the Equator. We will use Google Earth and Atlases to locate Brazil and Antarctica. We will study the physical and human features and discuss the similarities and differences between Brazil and Antarctica.

Music

As musicians, the children will develop their knowledge and understanding of dynamics using instruments; learning to compose and play rhymes to represent planets.







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As athletes, the children will learn how to dribble using their hands and feet, finding space and throwing with increasing accuracy. We will use the terms 'attacking and defending' when playing team games.
